What is c-TRAK TN?


c-TRAK TN is a national clinical trial that is being co-ordinated by Clinical Trials and Statistics Unit at The Institute of Cancer Research, London. It is trying to find out:

If a blood test can identify TNBC patients who are at risk of relapse

And whether further treatment may or may not prevent or delay the cancer coming back if a blood test is positive

What does the trial involve?

Patients who are eligible and agree to take part may follow a pathway that looks like this:
